All schedules and entries are tentative until heat sheets come out the day of or prior to competition. Heat sheets and final schedules will be emailed to you and available on [www.gojaspers.com](http://www.gojaspers.com).

**Admission:** Spectator admission is free. Spectators must stay outside of the track.

**Facility Details:** Competition track is a flat 200 meter 5 lane Mondo track with one Mondo long/triple jump runway and a Mondo pole vault runway. The throwing ring is made of a reinforced wood surface.

**Implement Weigh-in:** Only indoor weights and shots are allowed. Implements must be weighed in at the throws area on the North end of the track starting 1 hour prior to competition.

### **Entries**

**Team:** All team entries must register online on the Direct Athletics website. Fee Schedule: \$10.00 per individual or team fee of \$250.00 per gender (\$500.00 per combined program). Cash or Check written to "Manhattan College Track" may be used for entry fees. Fees may either be paid during packet pick-up, or sent before the date of competition to: Manhattan College Track & Field 4513 Manhattan College Pkwy. Riverdale, NY 10471.

**Individual Unattached:** All unattached entries must register online on the Direct Athletics website. You will need to pay using credit card on the website.

**NCAA Rule 4-1:** Misconduct is any act of dishonesty, unsportsmanlike conduct, unprofessional or breach of law occurring at the locale of the competition or warm-up that discredits the event or intercollegiate athletics. Misconduct includes the intentional reporting of false marks for entry purposes. Acts of misconduct are subject to reprimand or ejection by the referee or meet management. Accurate seed marks will assist us in accurately seeding the races and providing the best competition for your athletes. Meet management will use their discretion when setting up heats and flights.

**Event Check-In:** Athletes in running events must report to the clerk of the course located on the East corner of the facility. **If athletes fail to check-in 15 minutes prior to their event, they will be scratched.** Field event contestants should check-in with the head official in their event area.

**Parking:** Parking exists next to Draddy Gymnasium, however it is very limited. Cars and vans can park in the school's parking structure off of Manhattan College Parkway, and is free of charge. Buses can park in the Waldo Lot (Driving south on Broadway, make a right onto W. 240th St., drive to the end, lot is on right) next to Gaelic Park.

**Headphones:** NCAA rules do not allow for the use of headphones in the competition area.

**Results:** Results will be posted throughout the meet on the east and west walls and packets of results will be available for coaches at the finish line immediately following the meet's conclusion. Results will also be available on the Manhattan College website at [www.gojaspers.com](http://www.gojaspers.com).

**Shower/Locker Room Facilities:** Showers and locker rooms are available in the Visitors Locker Room located in Alumni Hall. Towels and locks are not furnished. Manhattan College takes no responsibility in any lost or stolen items.

**Team Camps:** All team camps are to be kept on the infield of the track. Please utilize bleachers. **No Tents Allowed.**

**Track Shoes:** Only quarter inch spikes will be allowed. Spike size will be strictly enforced. Athletes not complying will not be allowed to compete.

**Trainers:** Manhattan College Training staff is located on the first floor of Alumni Hall (building adjacent to Draddy Gym).

**Warm-Ups:** All warm-ups are to be done outside the gym, or on the track surface out of the way of the competition area outside the gated area.
